Sec. 18-1. Adoption of County law.

Chapter 5 of the Montgomery County Code (1972), as amended, entitled "Animal Control" is hereby incorporated by reference and enacted as the Animal Control Code of the Village with the additions and amendments as set forth in this Chapter.

Sec. 18-2. Sections added.

The provisions of Chapter 5 of the Montgomery County Code (1972), as amended, for the purposes of and as incorporated in this chapter shall include the following additional sections:

- (a) *Section 5-40(A)*. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to keep or harbor swine, cows, cattle, goats, rabbits, chickens, ducks or other fowl, or cause the same to be kept or harbored in Chevy Chase Village.
- (b) *Section 5-41*. Any person who is charged by a Village animal control officer or fails to comply with any of the provisions of sections 5-26, 5-27, 5-28, 5-29, 5-30, or 5-39(c) as adopted hereby shall be guilty of a municipal infraction and shall be subject to such prosecution and penalties as are provided in Chapters 5 and 6 of the Chevy Chase Village Code.

Sec. 18-3. Sections amended.

The provisions of Chapter 5 of the Montgomery County Code (1972), as amended, for the purposes of and as incorporated in this Chapter, are hereby amended as follows:

- (a) *Section 5-1. Definitions.*

Animal control officer: The Director of the County Department of Environmental

Protection or his designee or the Village Manager, or his designee.

Sec. 18-4. Regulations.

(a) All regulations now adopted by the County Council and/or by the County Executive for Montgomery County pursuant to the authority contained in Chapter 5 of the Montgomery County Code (1972) as amended, are hereby incorporated by reference and shall be deemed to be in effect within the incorporated limits of the Village.

(b) All regulations or amendments to regulations hereafter adopted by the County Council and/or by the County Executive for Montgomery County pursuant to the authority contained in Chapter 5 of the Montgomery County Code (1972) as amended, as adopted by this ordinance shall become effective within the Village upon the effective date thereof unless an ordinance shall be adopted by the Board of Managers of the Village disapproving such amendments.

Sec. 18-5. Authorization to administer and enforce.

The County is hereby requested and authorized to administer and enforce the Animal Control Code of the Village within the incorporated limits of the Village as fully and to the same extent as Chapter 5 of the Montgomery County Code is administered and enforced in the County.

Sec. 18-6. Other ordinances.

Nothing herein contained shall in any way be construed as exempting compliance with any other applicable ordinances of the Village now or hereafter enacted.
