

## January 2023 CCVPD Highlights

### Operational

#### Two attempted commercial burglaries at Saks within a week\*:

- On Sunday, January 22 shortly after 1:00 a.m., three persons arrived in two cars and parked on Belmont Street. When they tried to break the glass door at the front of Saks, the alarm monitoring company called County Police. As the police arrived, the group ran to their cars and escaped.
  
- On Sunday, January 29 shortly after 11:00 p.m., a large group of people (estimated at 20 persons) arrived in 8 or 9 cars and attempted to smash the front doors of Saks. Again, the monitoring agency saw the activity and called County Police. Approaching sirens apparently scared the group off and the cars fled into DC.

*\*The Saks property is in the Village, but by agreement, the County Police are responsible for the Saks building, and the Village Police are responsible for the parking lot. These crimes are captured and reported by the County Police.*

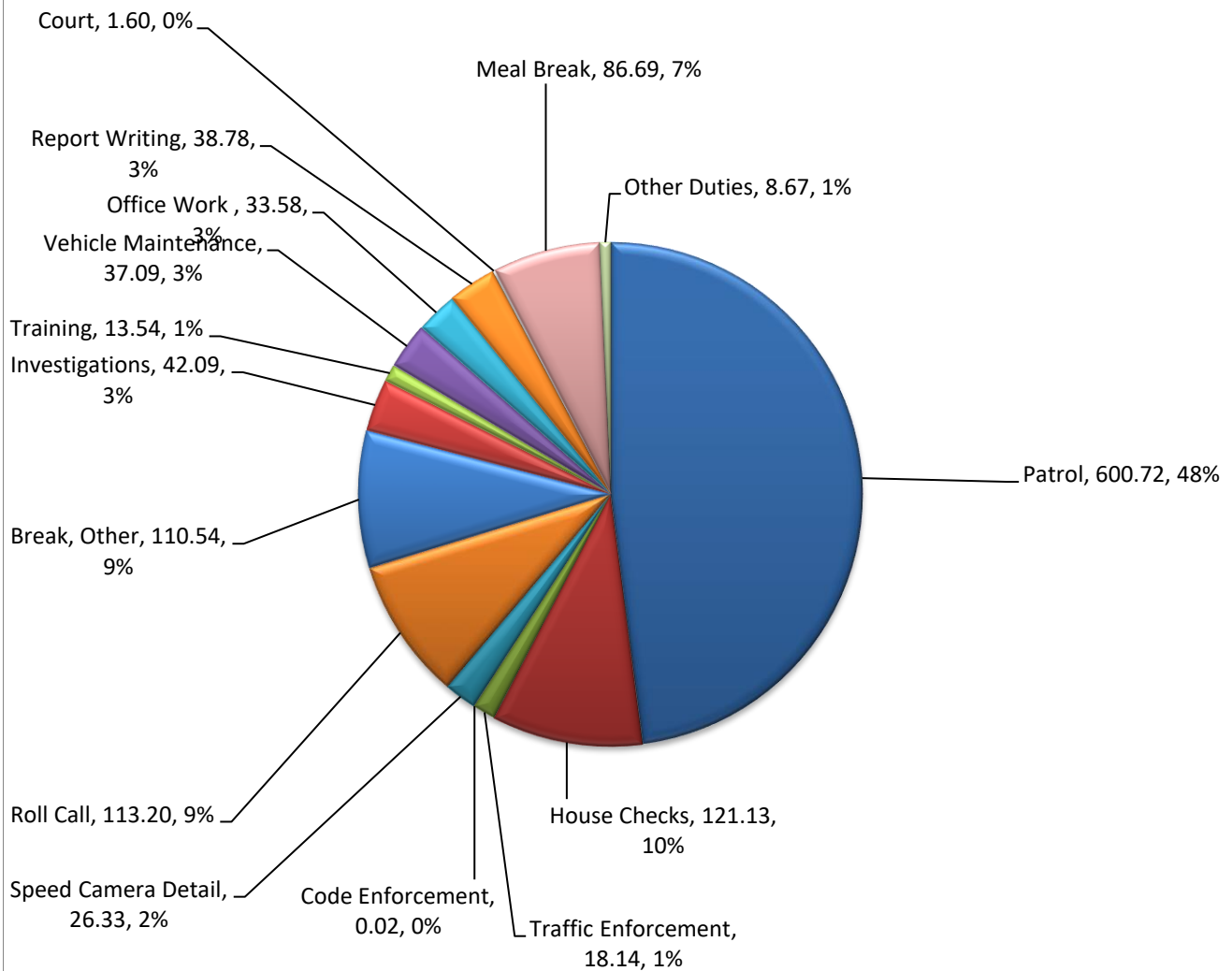

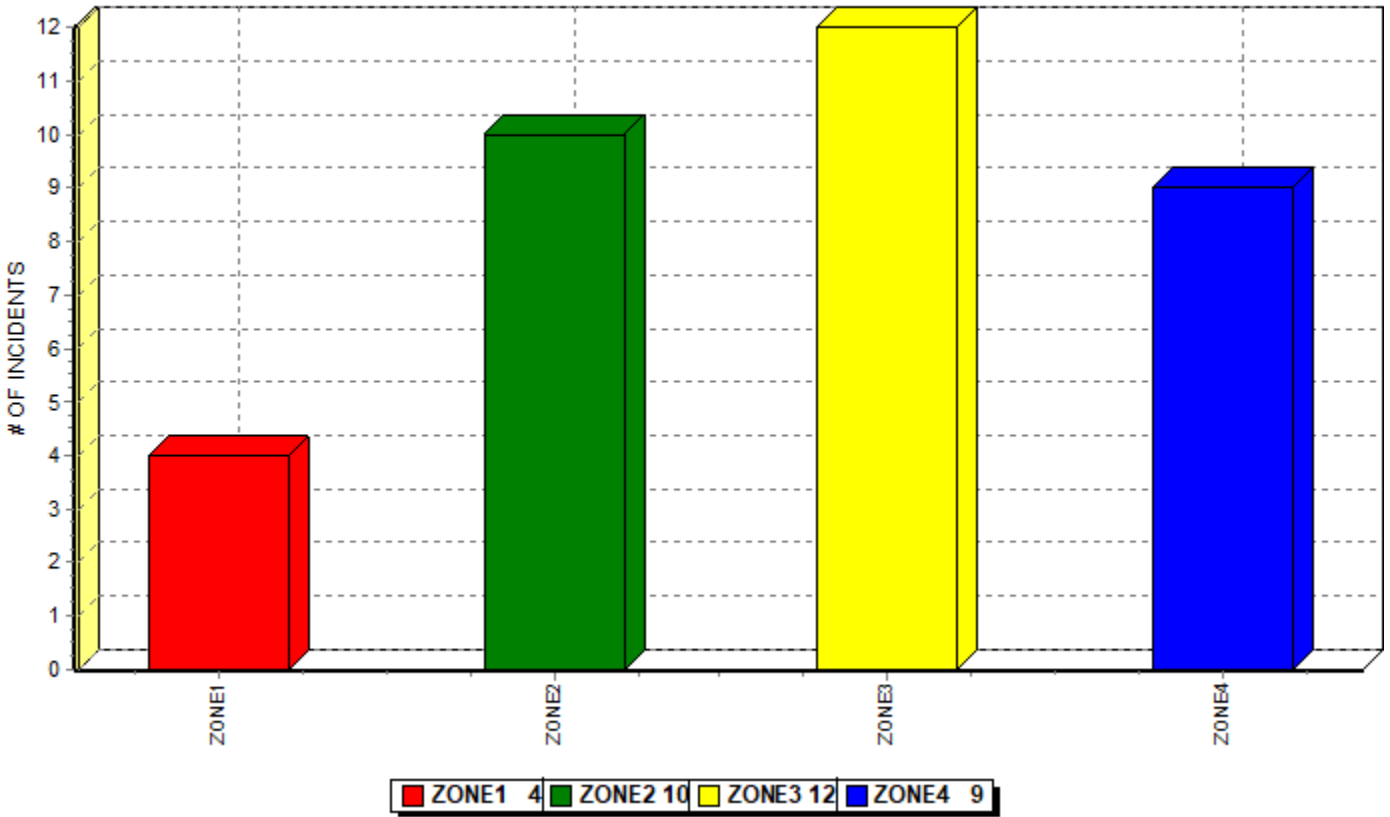

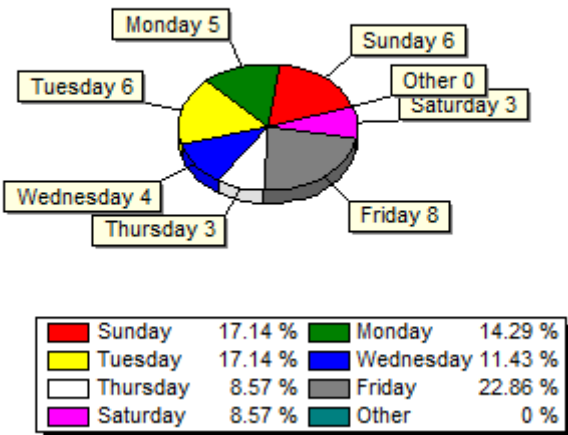

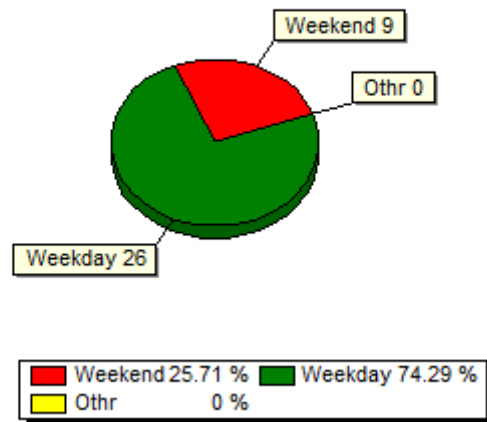
**Incident Frequency by DISTRICT (Top 4 of 4 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)**



**By Day of Week**

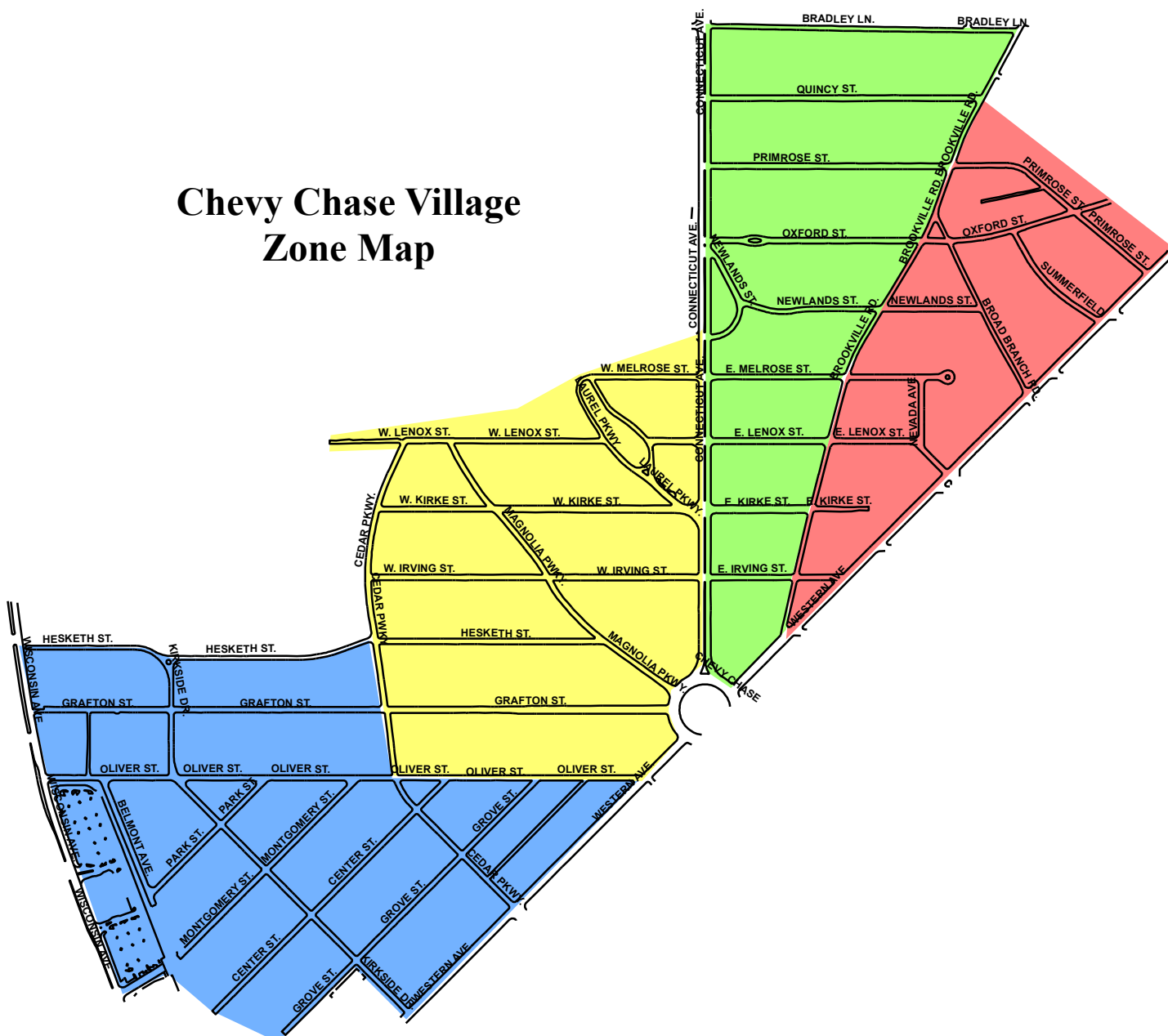


**Weekday vs Weekend**
