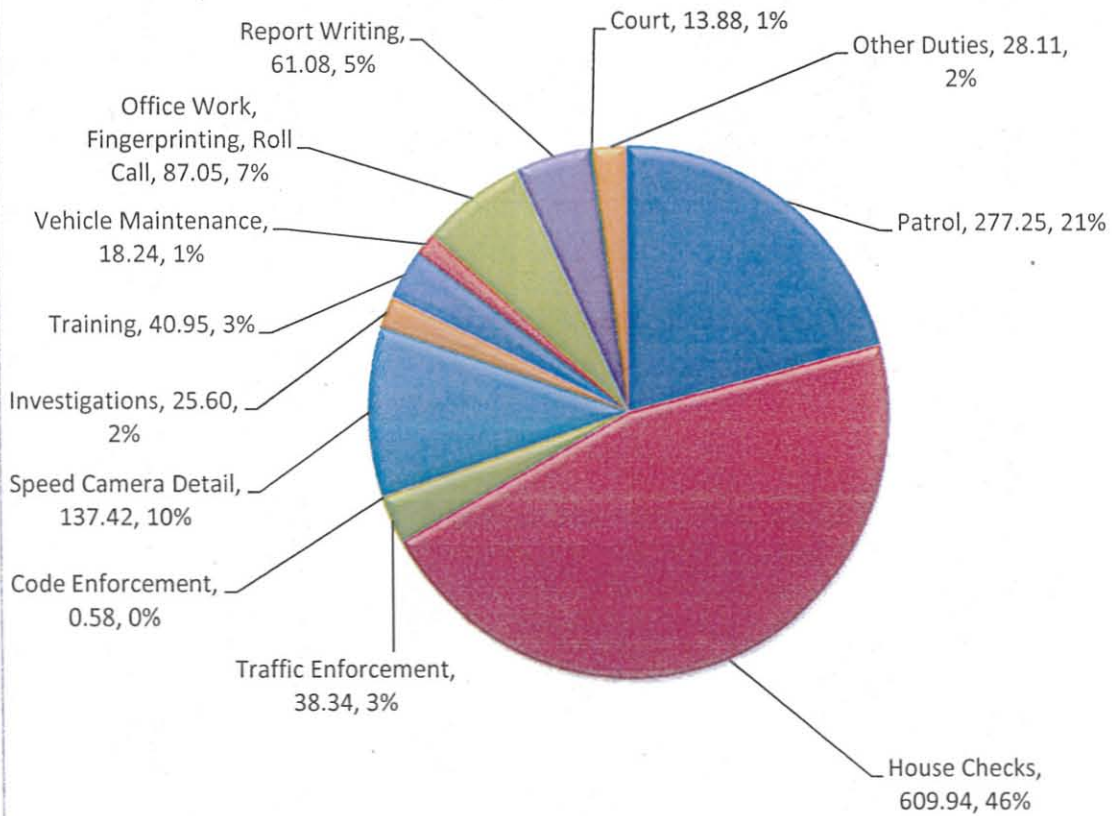

Chevy Chase Village Police Department Officer Hours for July 2011 within Chevy Chase Village



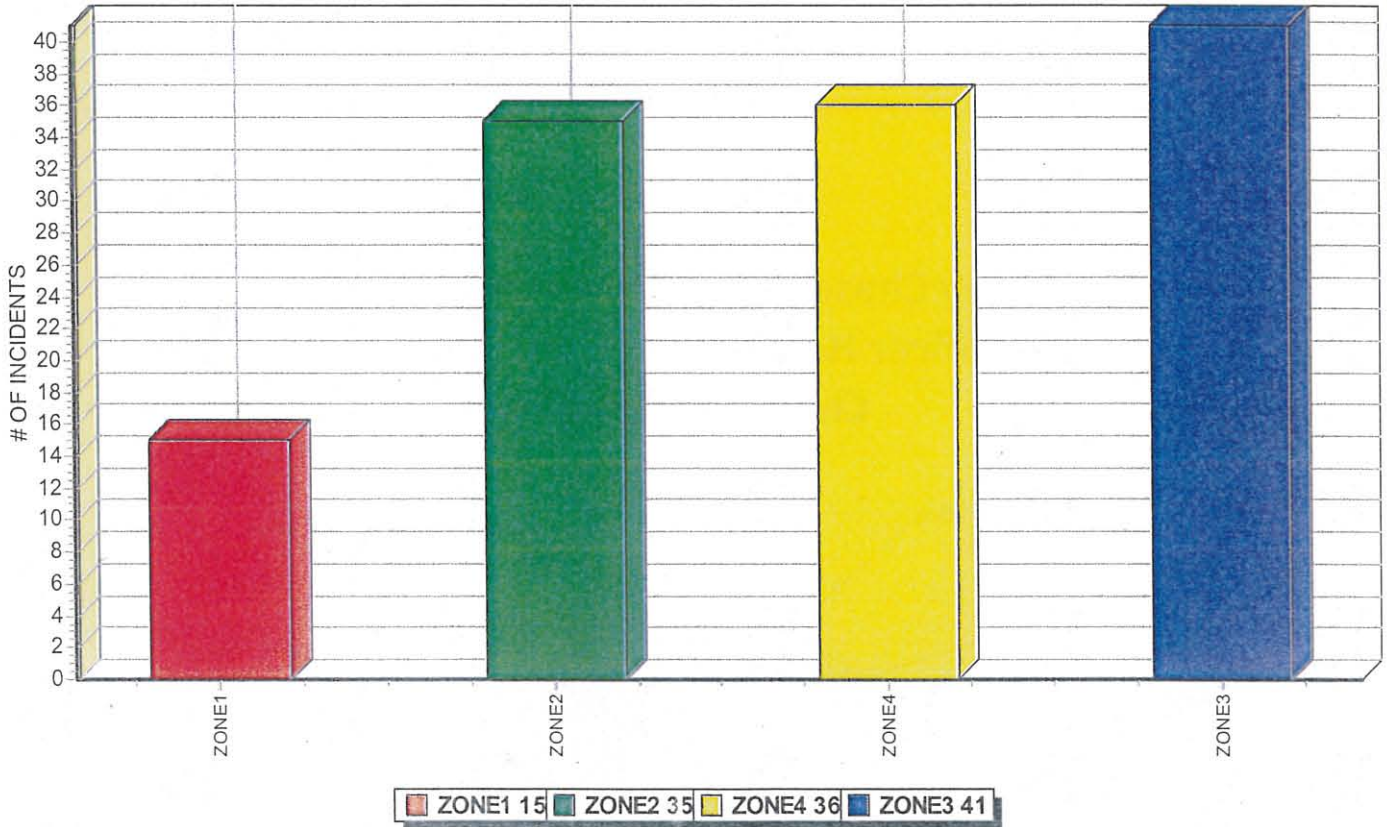

Police Activity Requiring A Report -See Zone Map

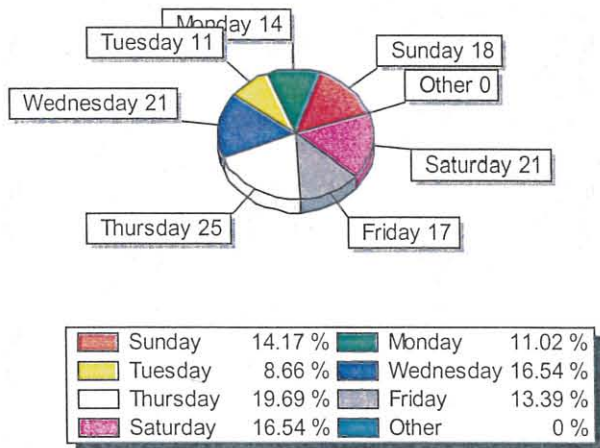

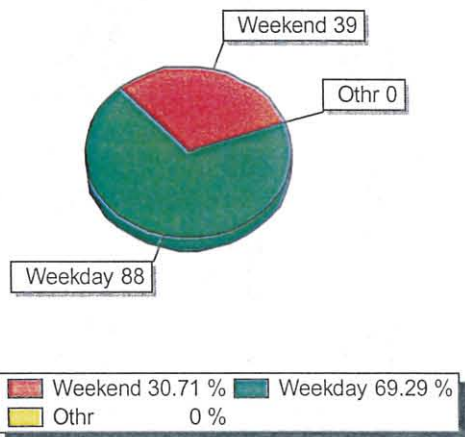
Incident Frequency by DISTRICT (Top 4 of 4 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)



By Day of Week

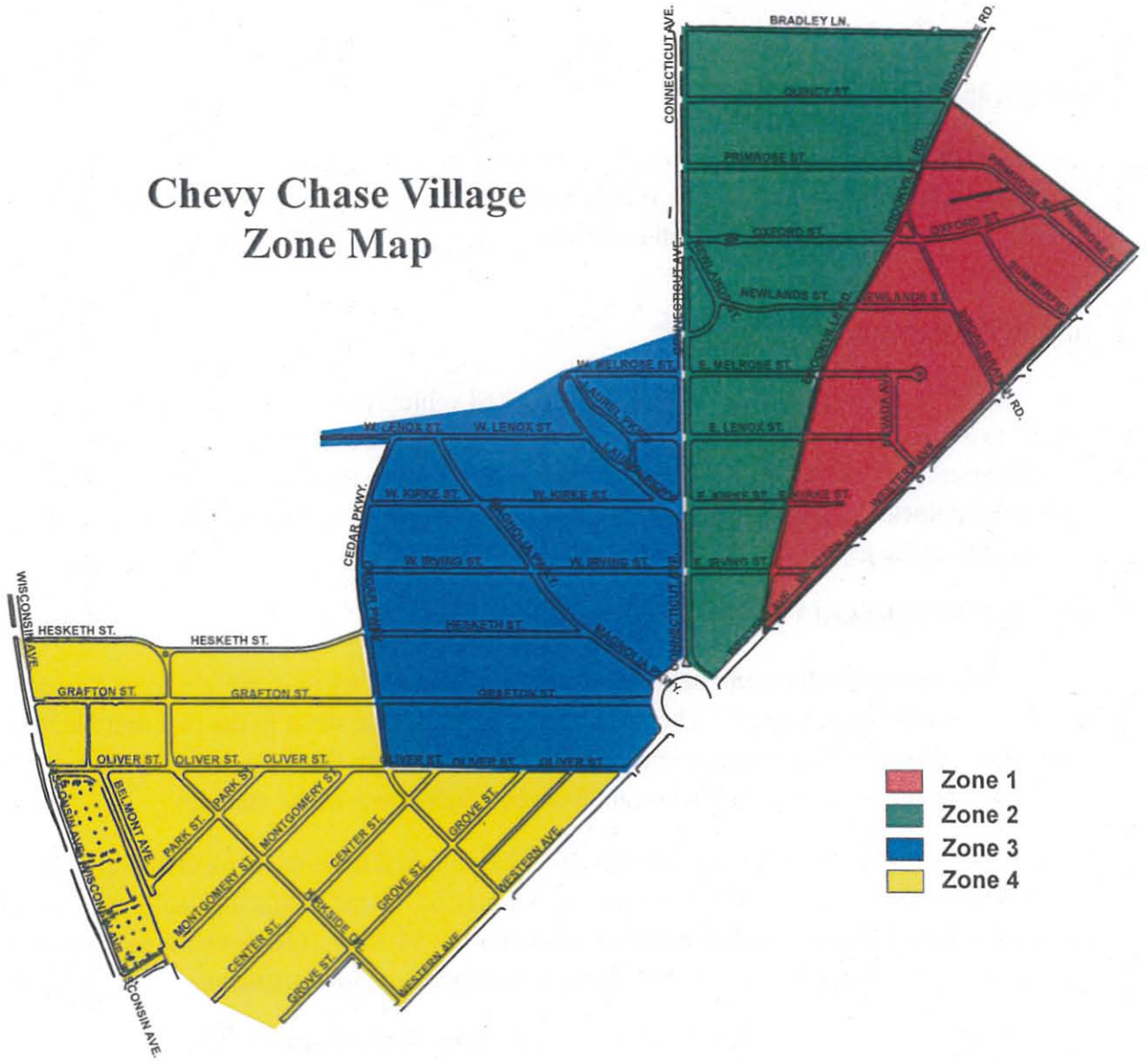


Weekday vs Weekend

Crime Activity

July 06, 2011 Unlocked Vehicles

Unknown suspect(s) went through an unlocked vehicle parked overnight from Tuesday, July 5th to Wednesday, July 6th. The vehicle was parked on the street in the 120 block of Grafton Street. Cash was taken from the vehicle.

July 09, 2011 Unlocked Vehicles

Unknown suspect(s) went through an unlocked vehicle parked overnight from Friday, July 8th to Saturday, July 9th. The vehicle was parked on the street in the first unit block of Hesketh Street. Sunglasses were taken from the vehicle. During the same timeframe entry was made to an unlocked garage in the first unit block of Grafton Street. July 27, 2011 Unlocked Vehicle / Stolen Vehicle

The vehicle was parked on the street in the first unit block of West Kirke Street. At the same location a Honda Pilot was stolen from the driveway that was left unlocked.
