

January 2017 CCVPD Highlights

I. Crime/Operational

- **One attempt theft from a LOCKED vehicle:** A resident witnessed a thief try to steal from a contractor's truck in the daytime, but the truck was locked and the thief walked away after trying unsuccessfully to open the truck's door. Nothing was taken. Locked vehicle 1, thief 0.

II. Administrative/Training

1. Our new handguns have arrived and we will be issuing them as soon as we are able to schedule the required qualification/practice at the range. Village counsel has provided a hold harmless agreement that we will use when our officers purchase the surplus firearms.
2. Six of our officers attended an 8-hour training on de-escalation techniques that are designed to avoid the need to use force. The training was presented by a nationally recognized trainer, and it was sponsored by the Gaithersburg Police Department (and free to us).

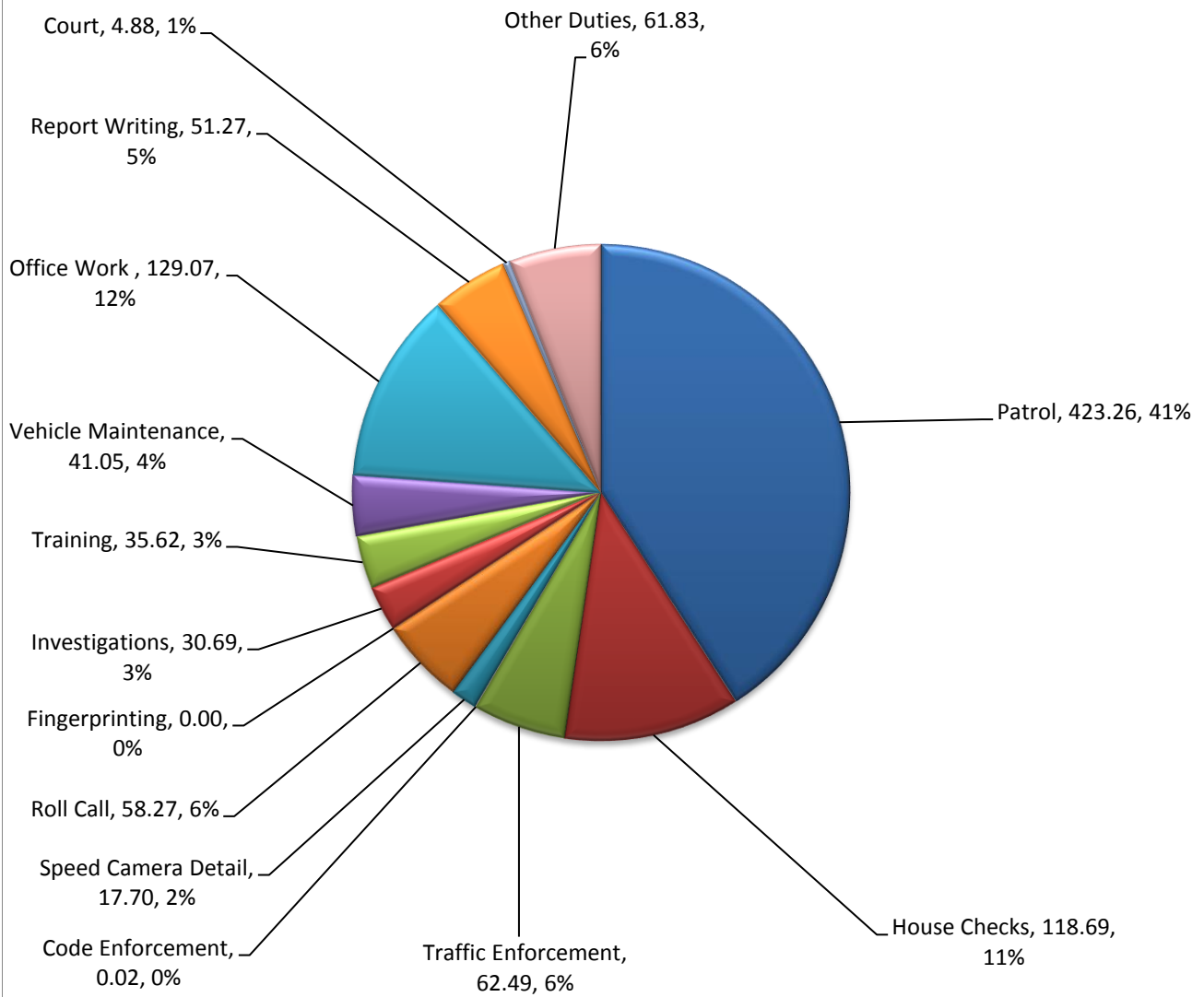

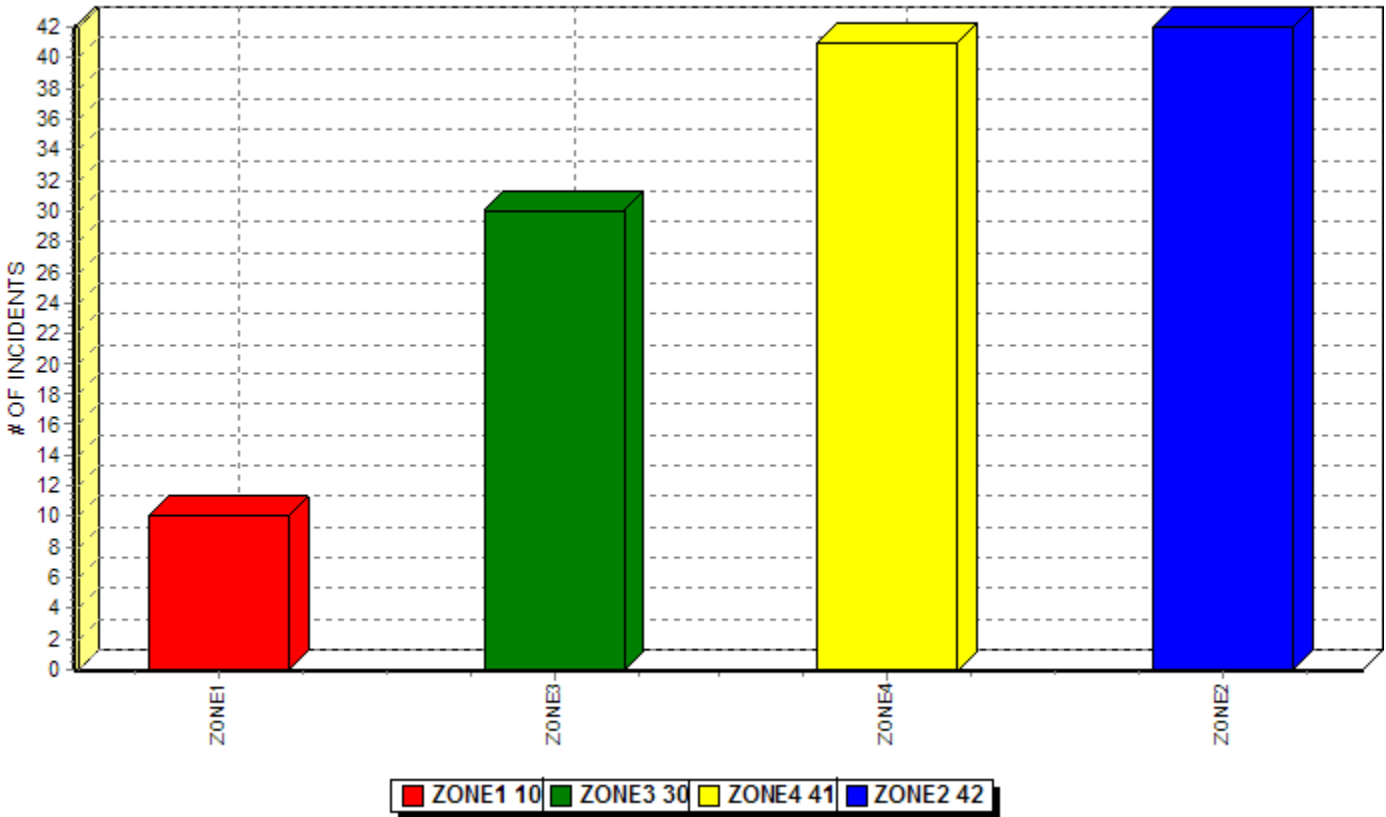

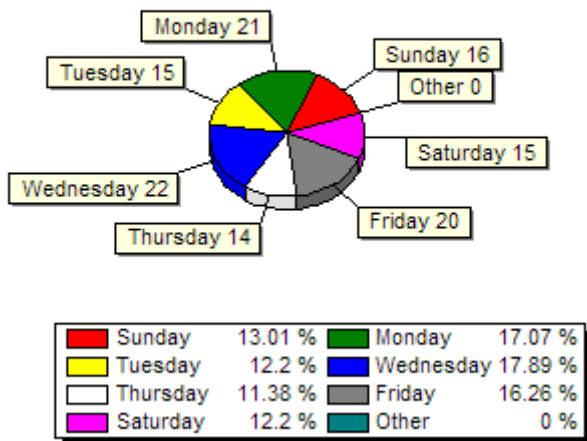

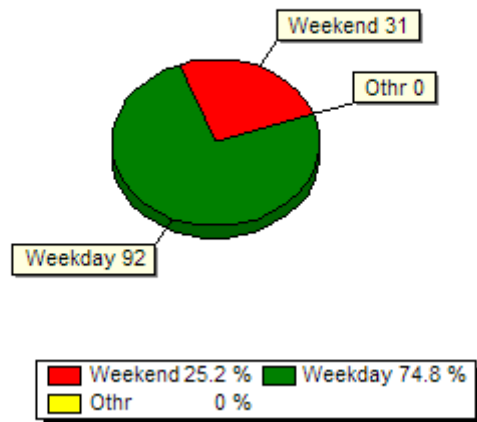
Incident Frequency by DISTRICT (Top 4 of 4 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)
