

July 2017 CCVPD Highlights

Crime/Operational

1. 3 unlocked cars entered:

- Grafton between Cedar and CC Circle; car was in driveway; \$20 in quarters taken
- 5500 block of Montgomery Street; car was in driveway; laptop, backpack stolen
- Unit block of Oxford Street; car was on street; \$10 in coins/cash taken

2. Two theft incidents occurred inside All Saints Church:

- Wallet stolen from upstairs office on July 6; County Police were already investigating a series of these events and had previously identified a suspect; security video from the church confirmed that our suspect was the same man involved in the county incidents; suspect has been arrested by a County Police detective for the spree.
- Wallet stolen from preschool office on July 18; church staff followed homeless female thief as she walked away from the church; Village Officer Fones responded and stopped suspect; wallet recovered and victim did not want to press charges.

On Thursday, July 20, Chief Fitzgerald met with the pastor, Rev. Ed Kelaher, All Saints to discuss crime prevention measures. Rev. Kelaher had already come up with a plan to make significant changes to the facility (adding secure interior doors to restrict access) which should go a long way toward reducing these crimes.

Administrative

- 1. Contract discussions held with Conduent (speed camera vendor):** We reached agreement on our requirements for a new 3-year contract which will begin on 1/1/18. Conduent reps will generate the first draft of a written contract. After Village counsel reviews and edits the document, we hope to bring a final contract to the Board for approval in the last quarter of this calendar year.
- 2. Dispatcher on extended sick leave:** Bruce Gessford, our lead Communications Clerk, underwent a surgical procedure on 7/31. He is expected to return toward the end of August.

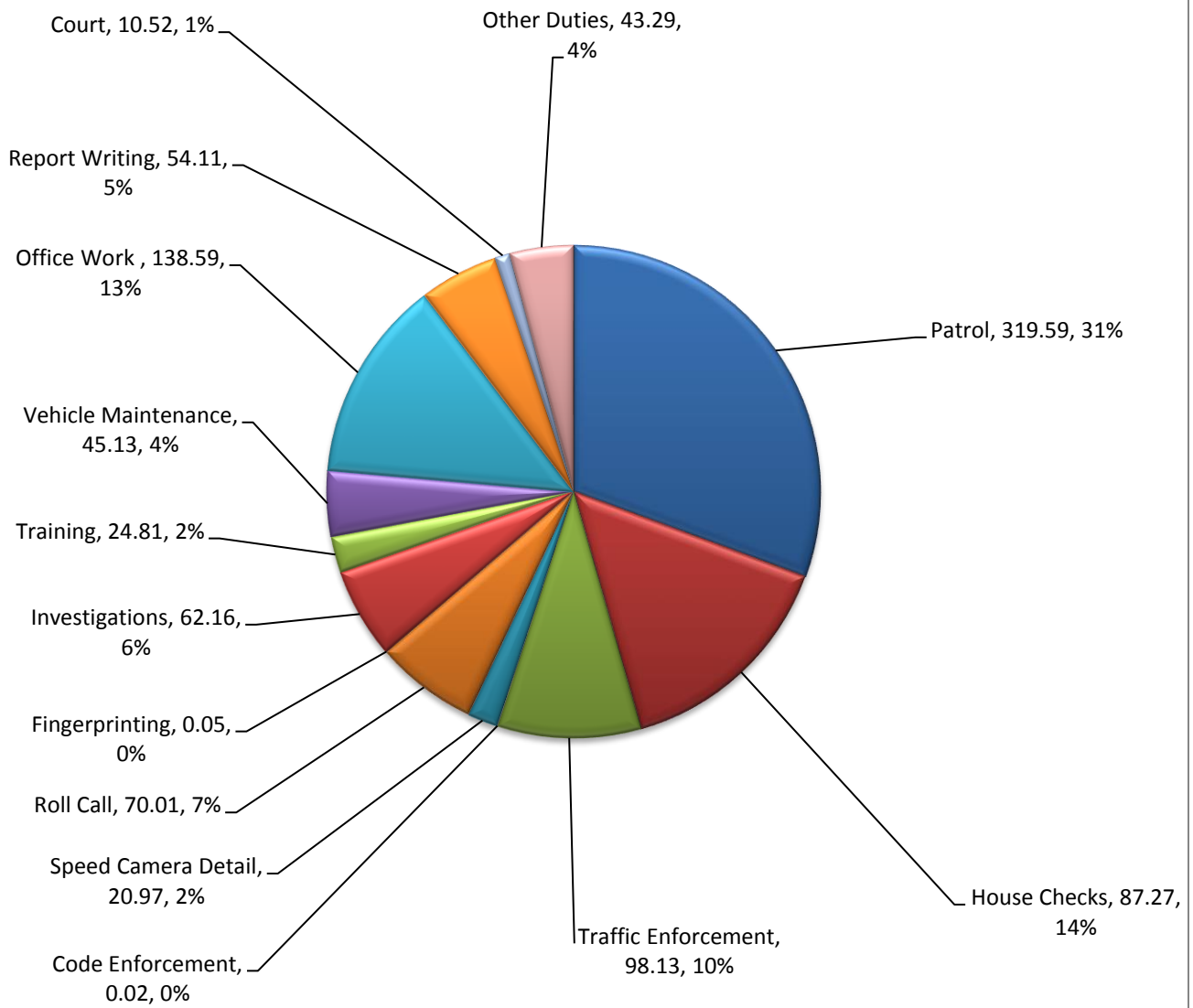

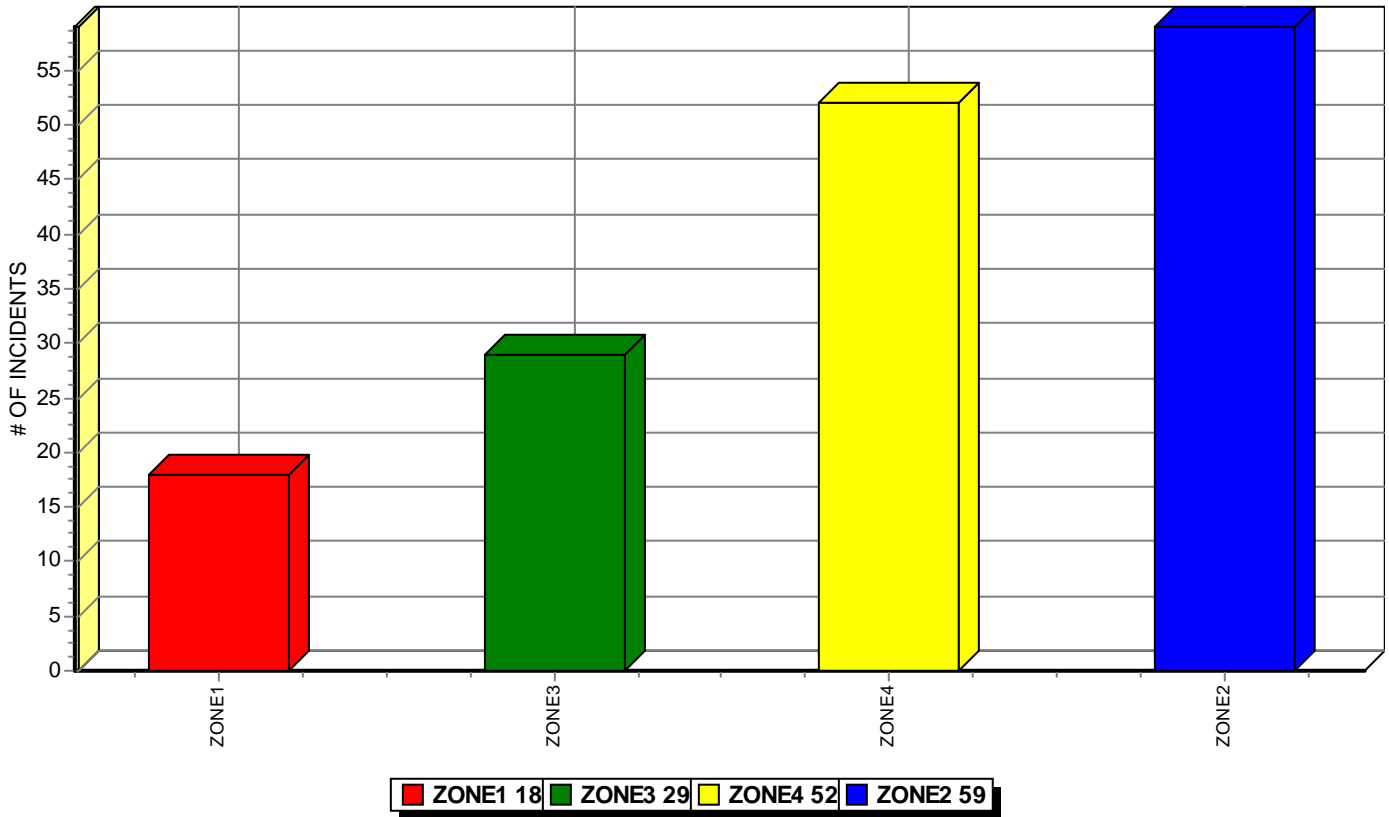

Chevy Chase Village Police Department Officer Hours for July 2017 within Chevy Chase Village

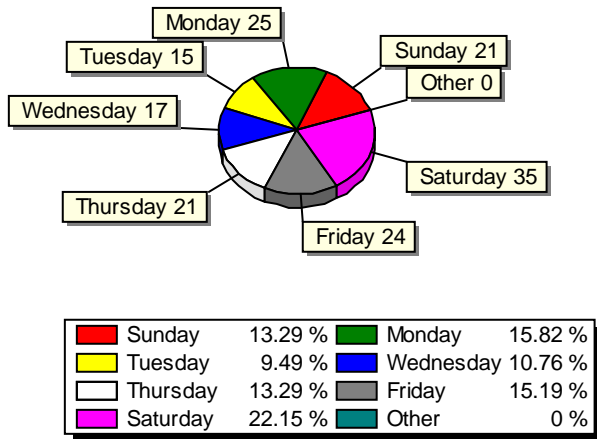

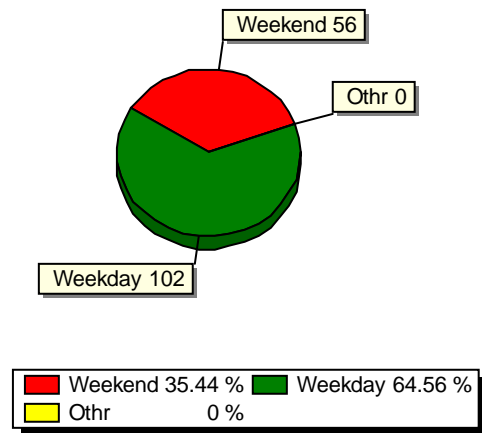
Incident Frequency by DISTRICT (Top 4 of 4 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)



By Day of Week

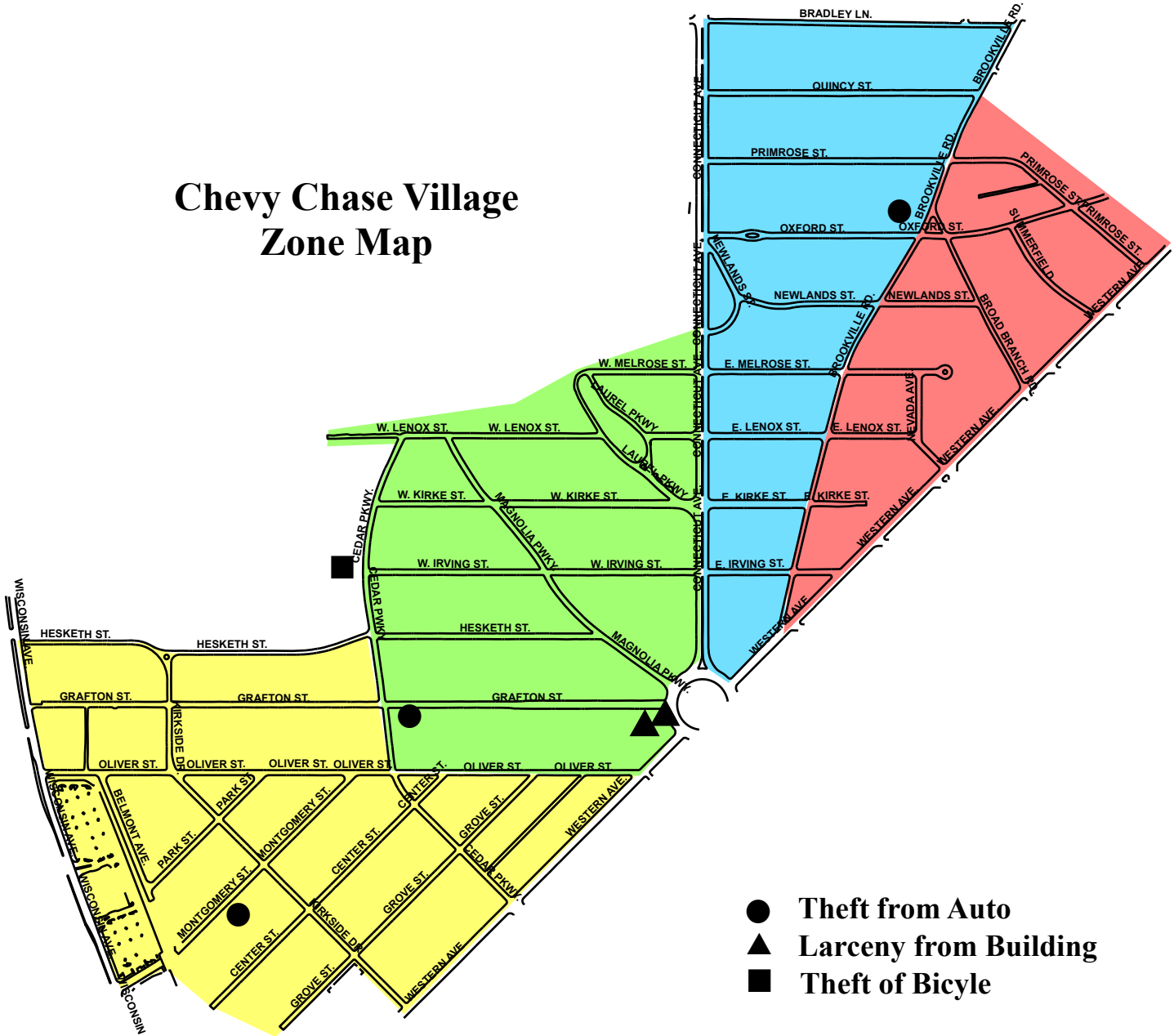


Weekday vs Weekend
