

December 2017 CCVPD Highlights

Crime/Operational

1. **6 theft-from-vehicle events; every vehicle was unlocked:**
 - 100 block of Oxford Street: \$300 cash taken from a contractor's truck
 - 5500 block of Center Street: EZPass transponder stolen
 - 5600 block of Park Street: Nothing taken
 - 3900 block of Oliver Street: Nothing taken
 - 4000 block of Oliver Street: Nothing taken
 - 5600 block of Western Ave (alley): Designer umbrella (\$800) and designer bag (\$3500)

2. **Stolen car (key inside vehicle):** 5500 block of Center Street. The unoccupied car was recovered one week later in Washington, DC. Investigation continuing.

3. **Holiday season package theft prevention initiative concludes:** We had only 1 reported theft of a package during the period between Thanksgiving and Christmas. Officers relocated many packages from front porches/stoops to hidden locations to deter thieves.

Administrative/Upcoming

1. We have re-posted our police officer position vacancy announcement.

2. The 2018 Maryland legislative session will run from January 10 through April 9; Chief Fitzgerald will continue on the Maryland Chiefs and Sheriffs joint legislative committee.

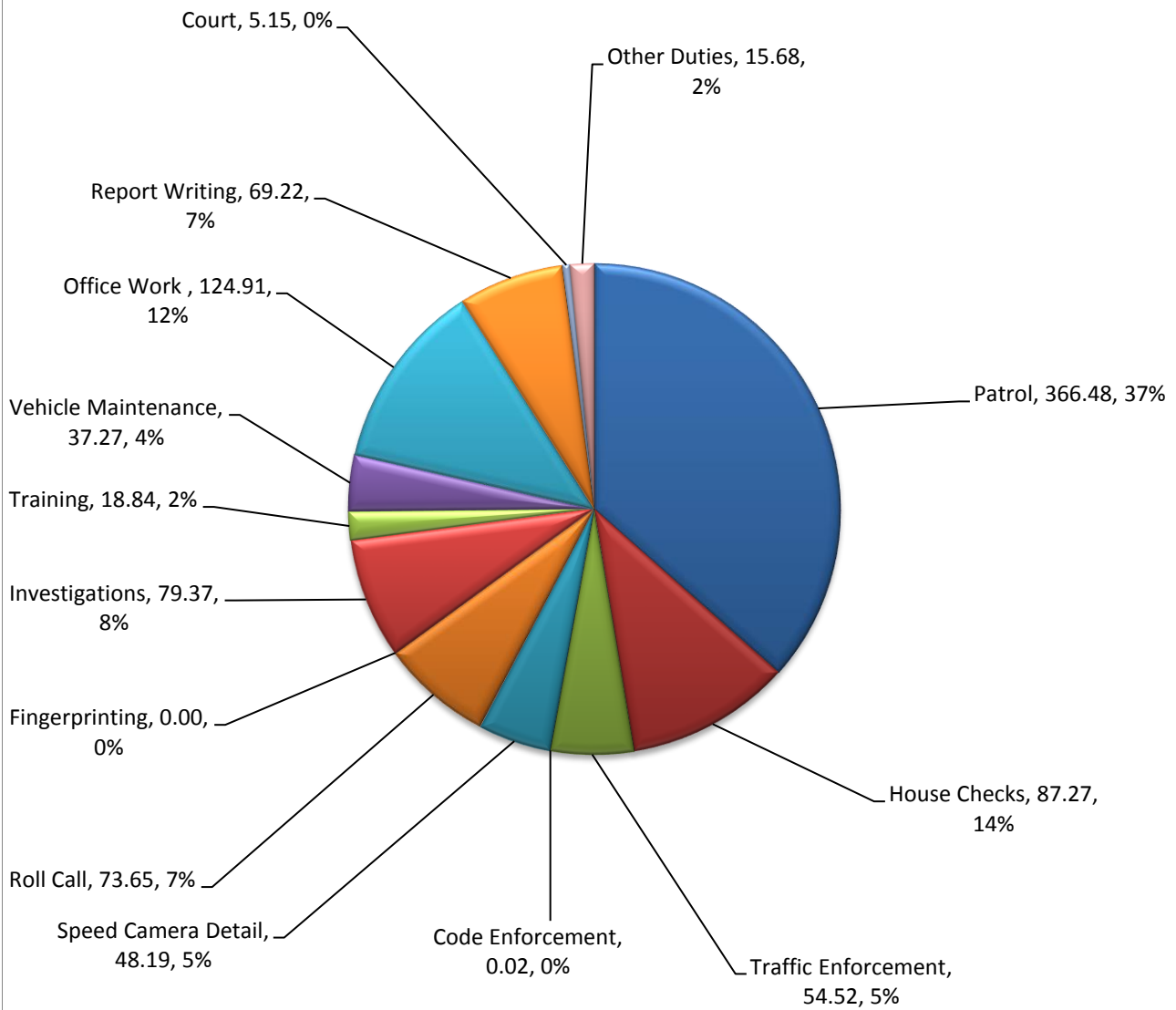

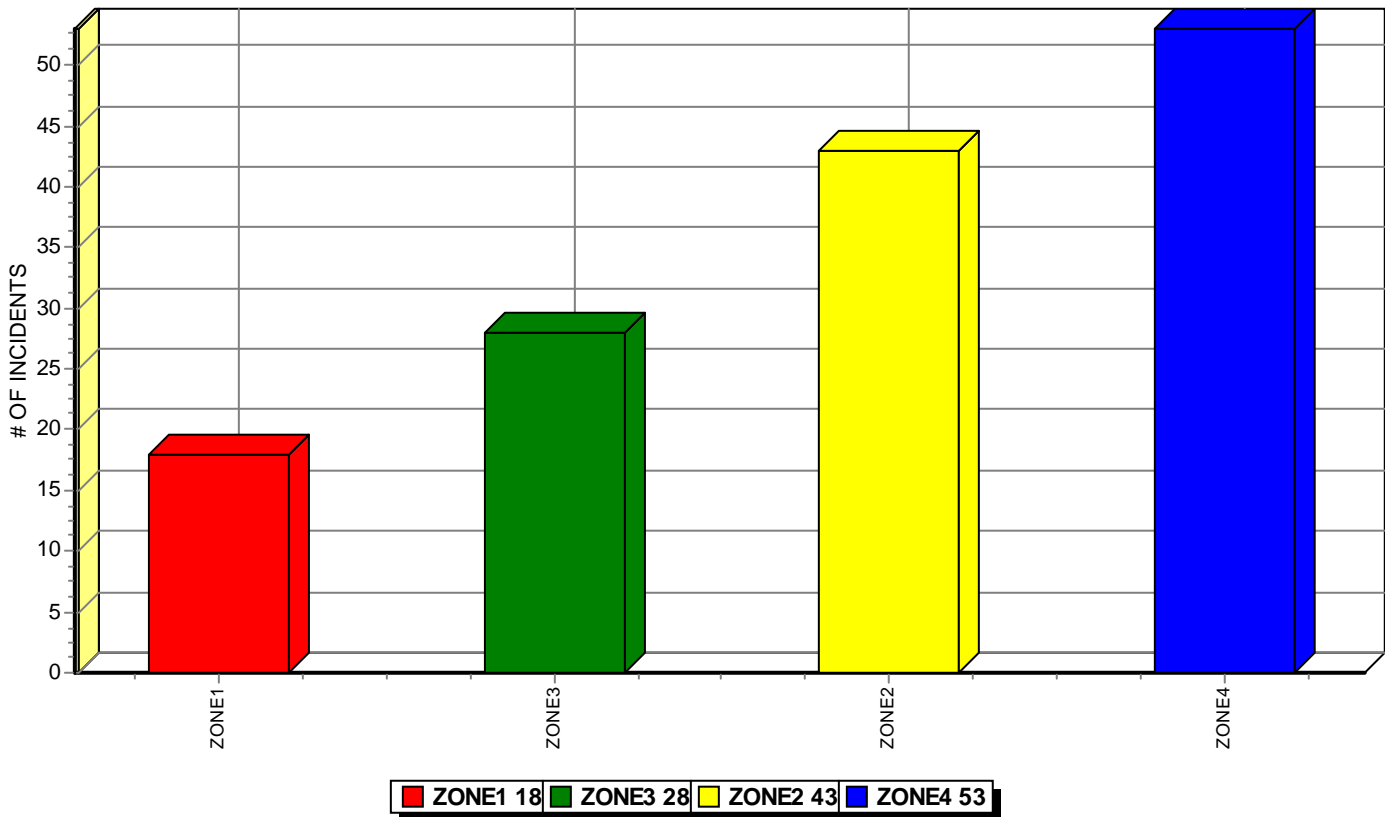

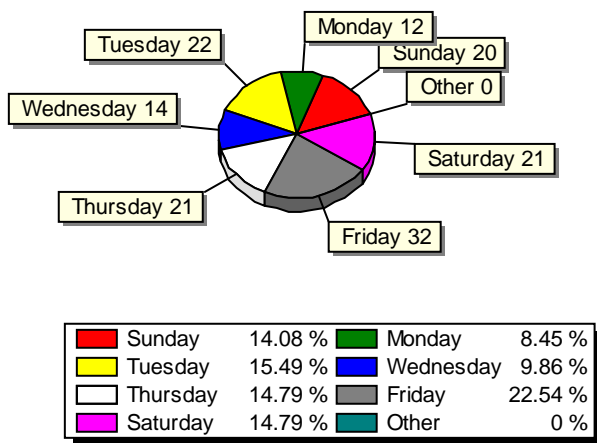

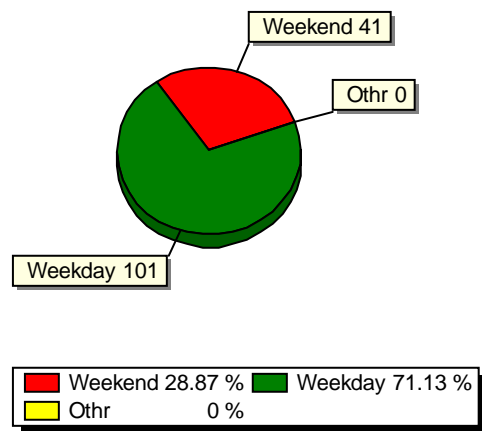
Incident Frequency by DISTRICT (Top 4 of 4 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)
