Crime/Operational

- **Newlands Street between Brookville and Broad Branch:** Bicycle valued at \$2300 stolen from unsecured shed
- **6300 block of Broad Branch Road:** Amazon packages stolen from front porch
- **W. Kirke between Magnolia and Cedar Parkway:** hardhat and printer taken from empty, unsecured home under renovation

Administrative

- National Night Out took place on August 7 at Newlands Park. This year, along with the presence of county police, fire/rescue and the B-CC Rescue Squad, we were happily surprised by the arrival of 2 horse-mounted officers from the US Park Police. They committed to returning next year.
- Beginning on August 30 and continuing into mid-September, Chief Fitzgerald and three other police leaders are providing four training sessions in locations around the state to help law enforcement agencies prepare for some important new laws that go into effect on October 1.

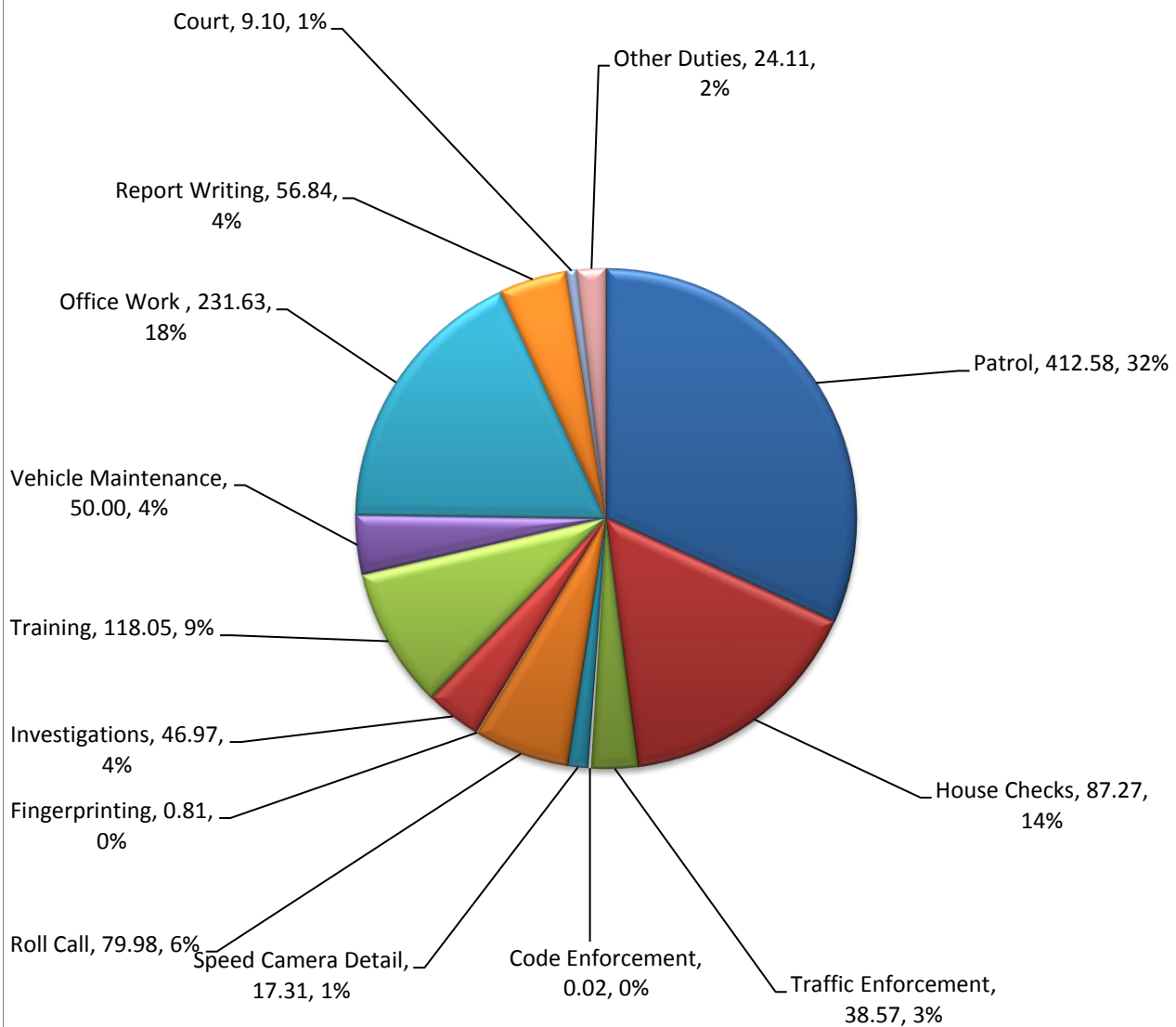

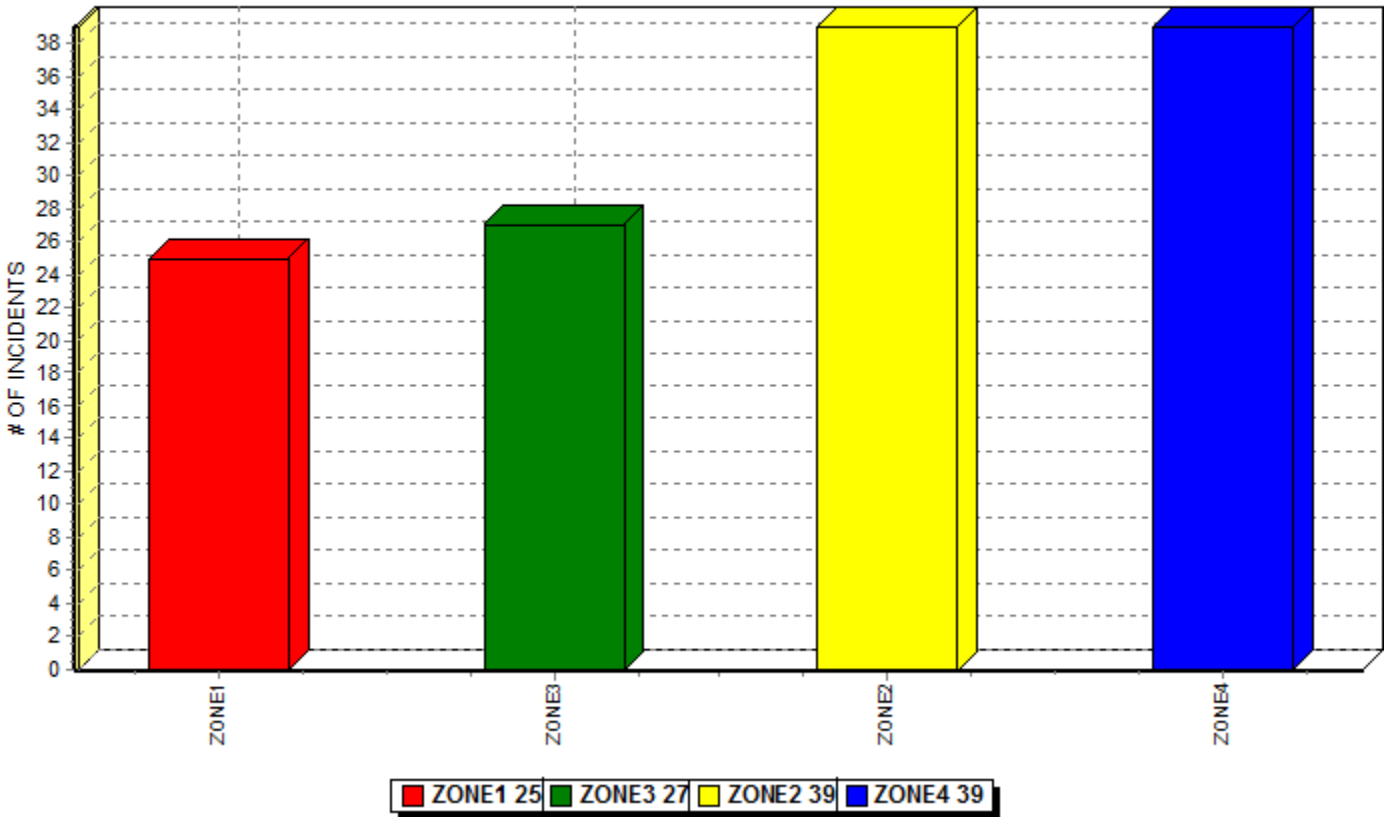

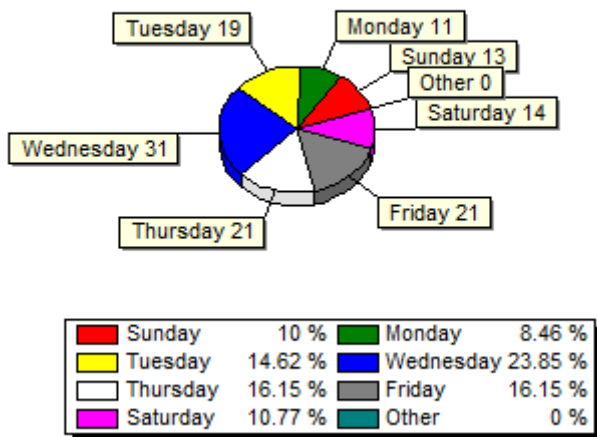

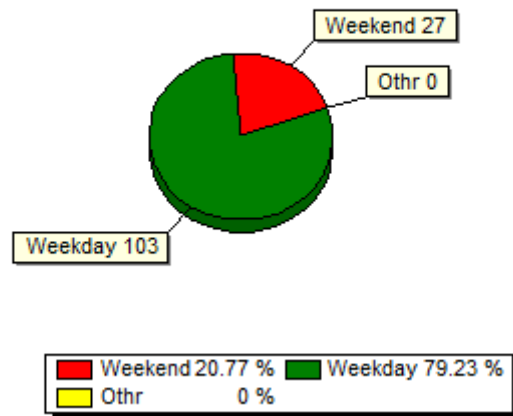
Incident Frequency by DISTRICT (Top 4 of 4 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)
