

September 2020 CCVPD Highlights

I. Reported Crime:

1. **Daytime unlocked work trucks entered:** On 9/17 and again on 9/25, thieves entered a total of 5 unlocked work trucks and stole backpacks. All of the backpacks were later discarded either in the Village or in DC and were returned to their owners after cash was removed. Officers did a great job working with DC police and victims to return the stole property. Locations include:
 - Grafton between the Circle and Cedar
 - 3900 block of Oliver
 - 5600 block of Montgomery
 - Oxford between Connecticut and Broad Branch
 - Primrose between Connecticut and Brookville

2. **Nighttime unlocked cars entered:** Overnight 9/8-9/9, 3 unlocked cars were rummaged through; nothing was taken. Locations include:
 - W. Irving between the Circle and Magnolia
 - 5800 block of Connecticut

II. Administrative:

- The second ‘old’ police car sold at auction for **\$12,100**. That’s an excellent price and more than expected. The two recently auctioned cars sold for a combined **\$20,588**.








Incident Frequency by DISTRICT (Top 4 of 4 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)
