

January 2022 CCVPD Highlights

I. Operational

- **11 unlocked cars entered on January 14:** A group of thieves in two vehicles—one thief apparently armed with a handgun—entered multiple cars on Hesketh Street and W. Irving Street between 5am and 6am. Although nothing was taken from most of the cars (items were stolen from only 3 cars: quarters; Christmas lights; a wallet), this event underscores how unlocked cars provide easy opportunities for criminals.
- **Two catalytic converters reported stolen overnight 1/4-1/5:** One occurred in the unit block of Hesketh, and the other in the middle block of Grafton. No one saw or heard anything. This is a trend nationally. Thieves target these converters for the value of the precious metals inside the devices.

II. Administrative

- On January 19, Chief Fitzgerald testified in support of **Senate Bill 31**, which would provide significant **privacy protections for body camera recordings**. Last year, this same bill passed 47-0 on the Senate floor, but it didn't make it back to the House for a vote there. It passed overwhelmingly in the House in previous sessions (130-8 in 2016; 133-3 in 2017), but it failed to make it to the Senate in those sessions. We are hoping for success this year.
- Chief Fitzgerald applied for a reimbursement grant from the Bureau of Justice Assistance for our body camera program; we were recently notified that the Village will be awarded just over \$20,000 which amounts to 40% of the cost quoted by our chosen vendor.

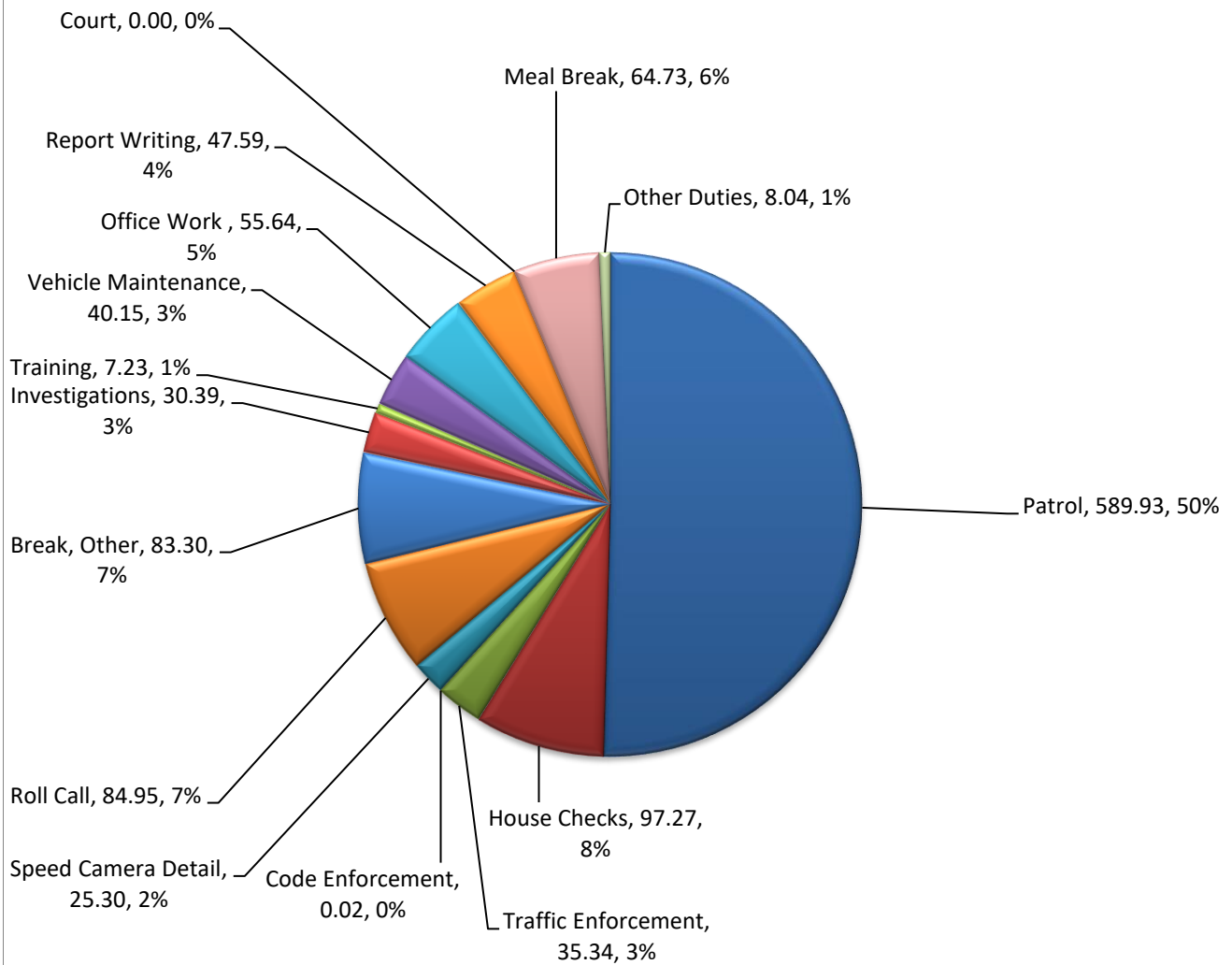

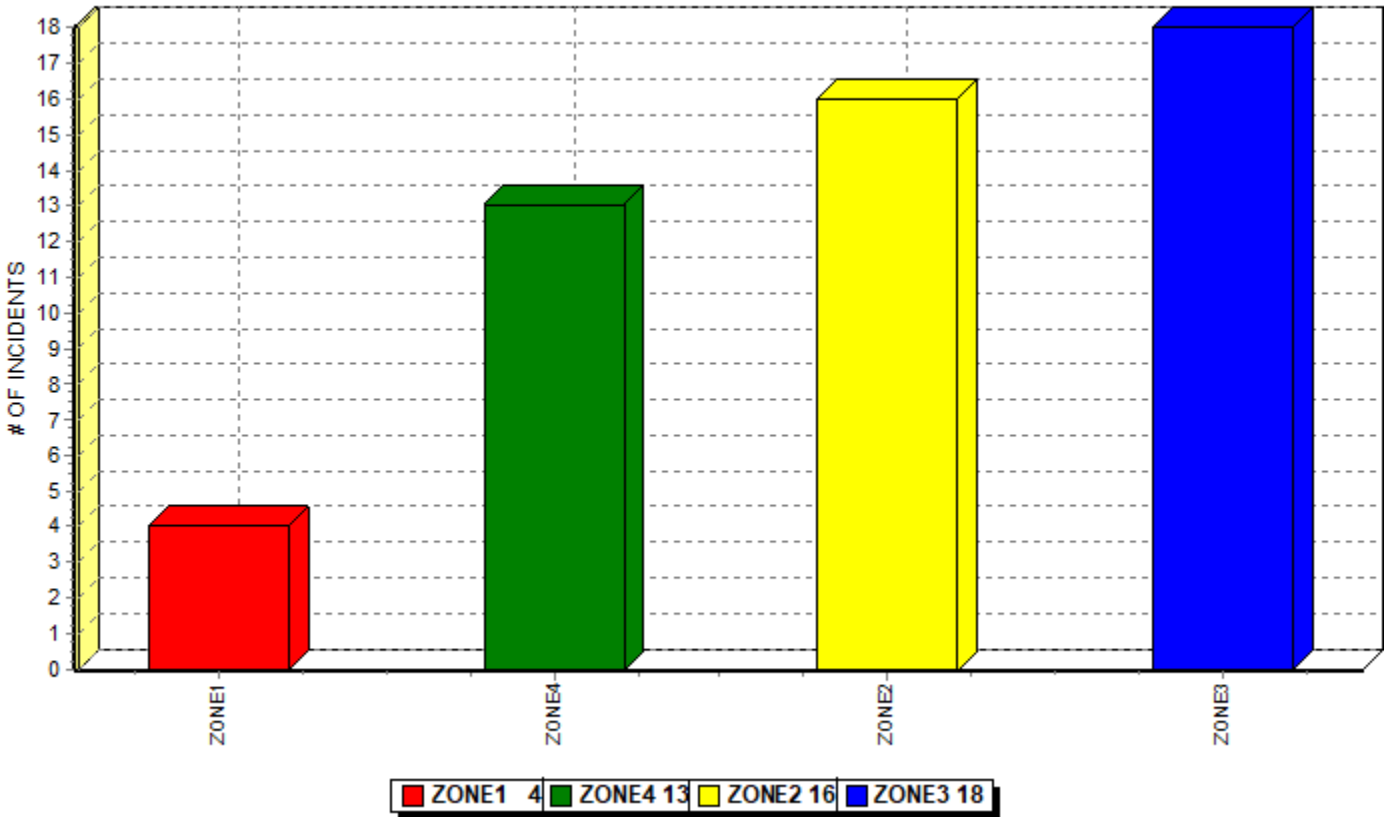

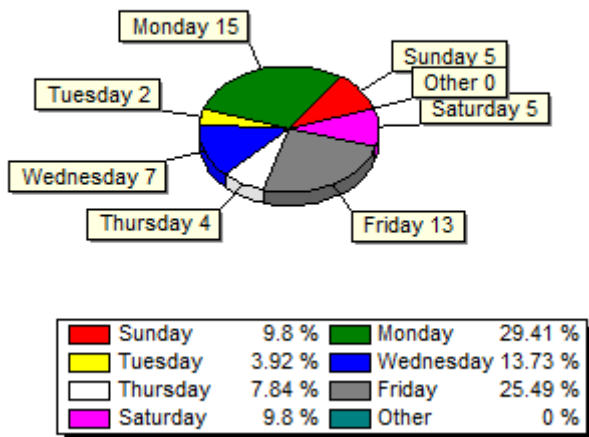

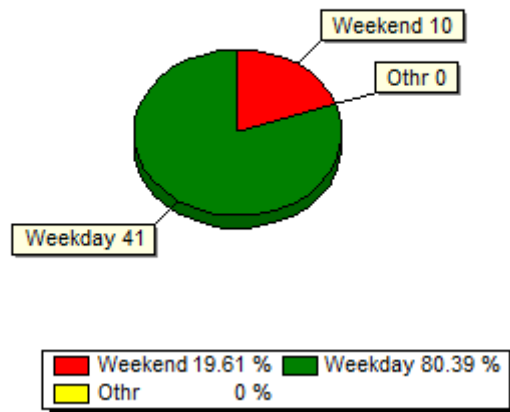
Incident Frequency by DISTRICT (Top 4 of 4 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)



By Day of Week

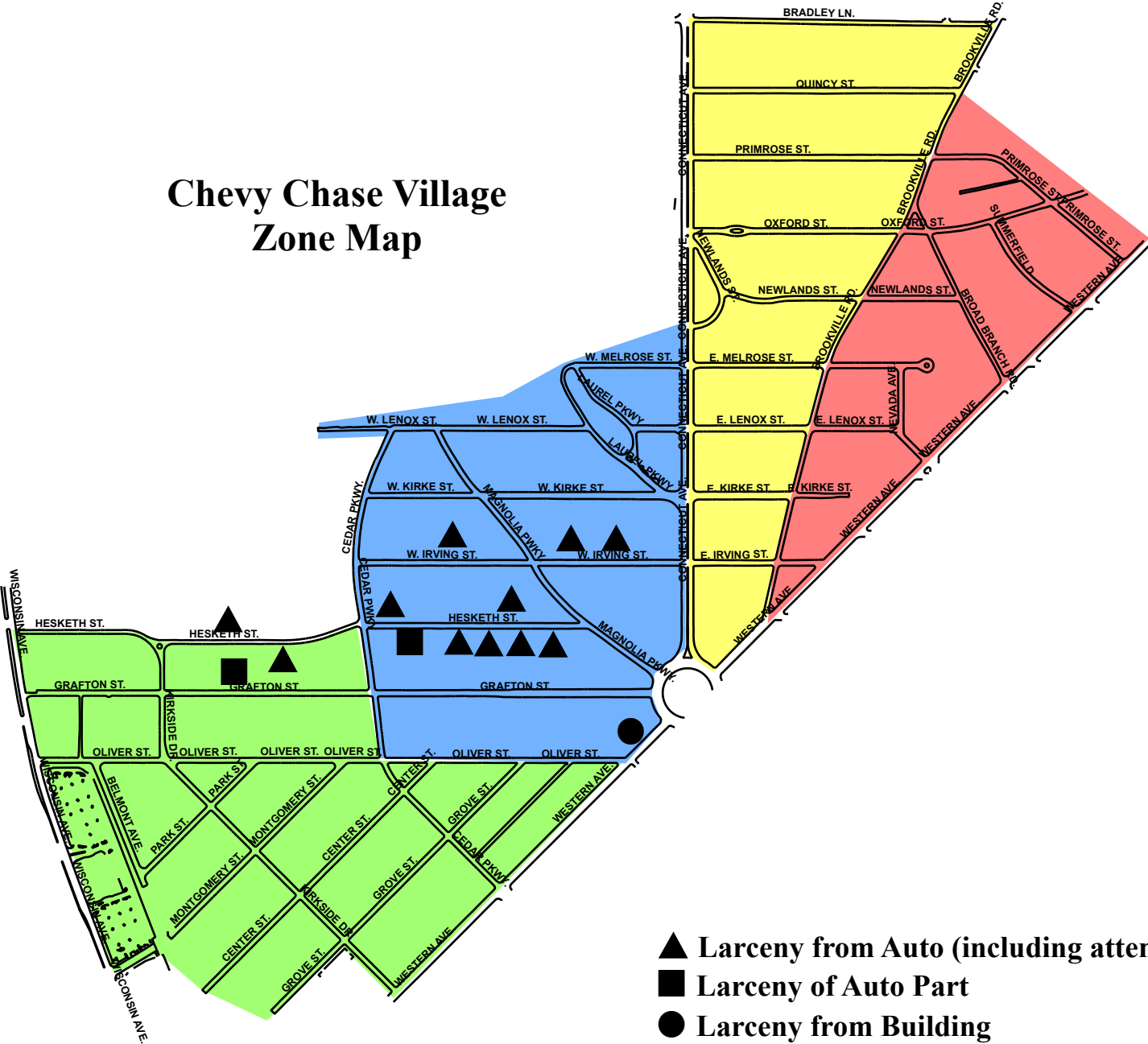


Weekday vs Weekend
