

## May 2022 CCVPD Highlights

### Operational

Three daytime thefts from vehicles:

- **6200 block of Western:** On May 2, credit cards were stolen from an unlocked work truck.
- **Unit block of E. Irving:** On May 16, a wallet was taken from an unlocked work truck.
- **Unit block of E. Lenox:** On May 18, a window was smashed on a car belonging to a domestic worker; a woman's backpack and cash was taken from the car.

### Administrative

- **Both new cars are now in service.** We now have 4 hybrid cars that are much more fuel efficient and will emit far less carbon monoxide and carbon dioxide into the environment than our previous gasoline-only cars.
- **We have recovered \$26,700 from the sale of our two old cars.** We sold both cruisers on a government auction site. The higher-mileage retired marked car sold for \$9,400. The low-mileage black SUV was in better condition and sold for \$17,300. The 2 new cars cost us about \$75,000, so the sale of the old cars represents a significant offset of the purchase price.
- **Chief delivered training on May 24 to all officers.** Officers received training on Maryland's new use of force statute, the new law dealing with police discipline, and a new statute placing strict limits on interviewing arrested juveniles.
- **Body cameras are in; training planned for all officers on June 14.** We will train all officers on our operational policy and we will also instruct the officers how to use the devices in a hands-on segment. The vendor has scheduled the remote deployment for June 27 and 28 so that our officers will be using the cameras by July 1 (our target date).

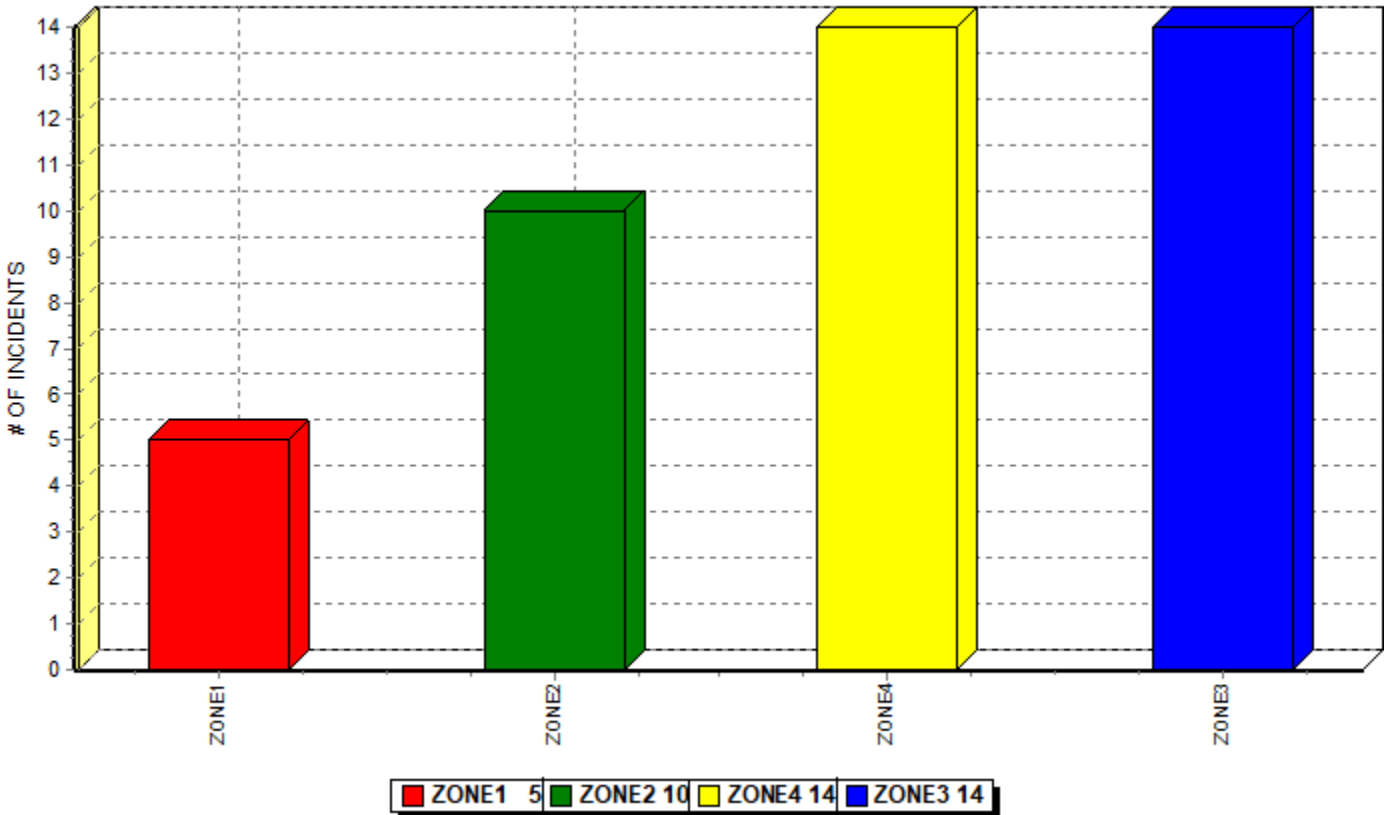

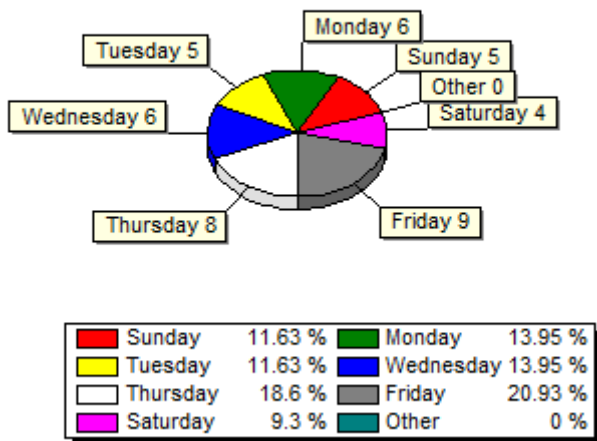

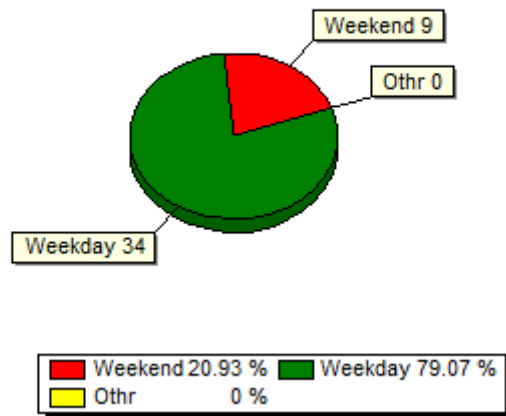
**Incident Frequency by DISTRICT (Top 4 of 4 Shown) (Using DATE RECD)**



**By Day of Week**

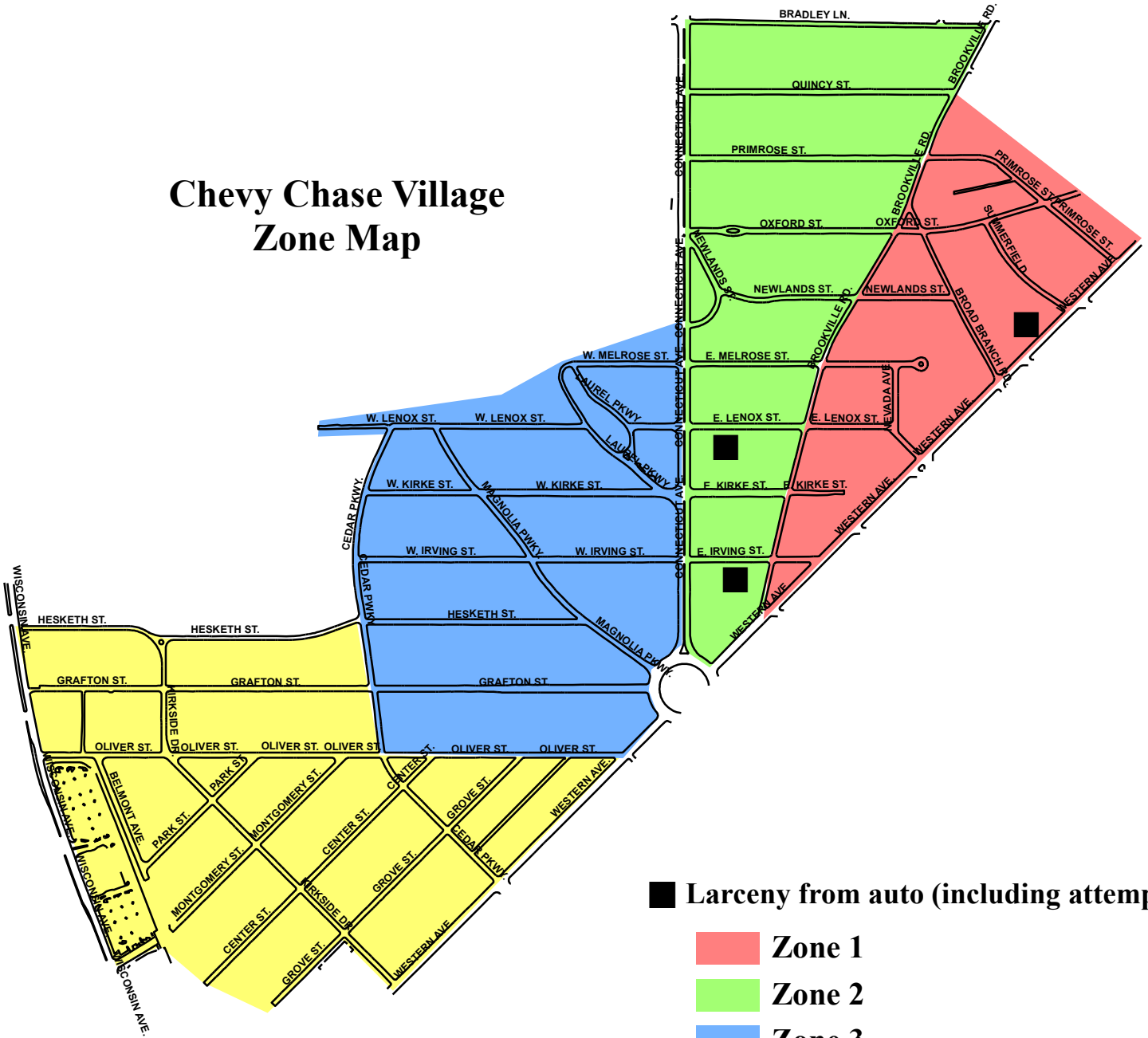


**Weekday vs Weekend**
