



2020 Board of Managers' Election Timeline

Date	Event	Explanation	
May 2, 2019	Residency deadline for candidates for the 2020 Board of Managers Election	Candidates for election to the Board of Managers must be domiciled in the Village one year prior to the election.	
February 2, 2020	Candidates Filing Window Opens <i>(90 days prior to Election Day)</i>	Candidates, including incumbents, may begin to submit their Certificate of Candidacy and Financial Disclosure Statement.	
April 2, 2020 (COB)	Candidates Filing Window Closes <i>(30 days prior to Election Day)</i>	Deadline for candidates to submit their Certificate of Candidacy and Financial Disclosure Statement.	
April 2, 2020	Residency deadline for voters	Individuals must be domiciled in the Village for 30 days prior to the contested election date in order to vote.	
April 12, 2020	Extension of Candidate Filing Deadline	In the event that 30 days prior to the election the number of candidates is less than the seats to be filled, the deadline will be extended for an additional 10 days.	
April 20, 2020	<u>Village Annual Meeting</u> Declaration of Successful Candidates <i>(When the number of candidates equals or is less than the number of available seats)</i> Declaration of a Contested Election <i>(When the number of candidates exceeds the number of available seats)</i>	During the Annual Meeting, the Chair of the Election Supervisors will <u>either</u> declare that the uncontested candidates are deemed elected <u>or</u> declare that there will be an election on Saturday, May 2, 2020, if the number of candidates exceeds the number of available seats. In the event of a contested election, immediately following the Annual Meeting, candidates will pull numbers to determine the order of names on the ballot.	
IN THE EVENT OF A CONTESTED ELECTION	Between April 22- April 30, 2020 (Specific date TBD)	Meet the Candidates Reception	Moderated by the Election Supervisors, this is a forum for dialogue between the candidates and the community. The forum is followed by a reception during which voters can discuss topics informally with the candidates. <i>See "Guidelines for CCV Board of Managers Elections Forum".</i>
	April 21, 2020	Absentee ballots available	Eligible voters may begin to request absentee ballots from the Village Manager's office. Village staff will make every effort to have these ballots available by noon.
	Between April 15- May 1, 2020	Special Election Issue of the Crier	Special mailing containing candidate-submitted profiles, information regarding the election, and an Absentee Ballot Request Form.
	Saturday, May 2, 2020	Election Day	Polls are open from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. at the Chevy Chase Village Hall, 5906 Connecticut Avenue, Chevy Chase, MD 20815. Absentee ballots must be returned before the polls close.
June 8, 2020	Regular Board of Manager's Meeting	Newly elected Board Members take office.
