Flu (Regular \$46 - Flucelvax and Fluzone quad / High Dose \$85 - Fluad and Fluzone HD) - For active immunization for the prevention of influenza disease caused by influenza virus subtypes A and type B viruses contained in the vaccine. Approved for use in people three years of age and older, including healthy people and those with chronic medical conditions, nursing mothers and pregnant women.

Shingrix (shingles vaccine) \$225 – For the prevention of herpes zoster (HZ) (shingles):

- in adults aged 50 years and older.
- in adults aged 18 years and older who are or will be at increased risk of HZ due to immunodeficiency or immunosuppression caused by known disease or therapy.

Boostrix (tetanus) \$75 – For active booster immunization against tetanus, diphtheria and pertussis in individuals 10 years of age and older.

Pevnar 13 (pneumonia vaccine) \$270 – Active immunization for the prevention of pneumonia.

Pneumovax (pneumonia vaccine, given one year after Pevnar 13) \$155 – Active immunization for the prevention of pneumococcal disease in persons 50 years of age or older and persons aged >2 years who are at increased risk for pneumococcal disease.

Payment Information

Most vaccines should be covered by insurance. Vaccine charges will be billed to eligible medical insurance, **Medicare Part B** (for flu and pneumonia ONLY, if not a part of an HMO) and **Medicare Part D** (for shingles and tetanus booster ONLY). Participants are responsible for eligible co-pay per their medical insurance coverage. **Participants must present their medical insurance/Medicare card and ID at the time of vaccination for medical insurance billing.**

Participants may pay eligible co-pays or make full payment via **credit card or check**, payable to *Giant Pharmacy*.
