**Subject:** Report on TC Meeting of August 29

At the Traffic Committee (TC) Meeting held Wednesday, August 29, we had good discussions on several issues as follows:

1. Chevy Chase Village Pedestrian Crossing: As indicated last month, the TC does not agree with the SHA approach. We hope that the Village will continue to seek a copy of the full SHA report on the matter. We urge the Board to seek a meeting between CCV, SHA, and elected Assembly members as suggested by Del. Waldstreicher.
2. Chevy Chase Circle: The TC remains skeptical of the proposed signalization and would like to be kept informed of developments. If it would be useful, TC members would be willing to attend DC meetings to better understand the DC position.
3. Parking Issues: The TC reviewed and discussed Village and Montgomery County code provisions on parking, focusing on CCV Section 14 and Section 13, Article III.
4. Request to revise time limits on parking on Kirkside between Western and Grove. The TC recommends against changing the time limits on this section of street. By the consensus of the TC, there was inadequate justification for the proposed change, and to do so would further undermine the existing uniformity of restrictions of the West Side.
